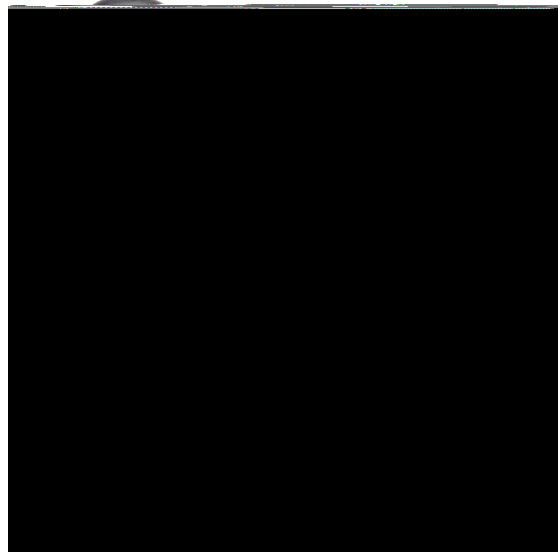

## Explanations

<b>Legend</b>	
	Lift the handset, or press the DN key, or press the Handsfree key.
	Replace handset, or press  to end the call.
	Dial a number.
	Press the line (DN) key.
▶AutoD1	The ▶ flashes when a feature is being programmed. The ▶ lights steadily when a feature is active.
<b>Remarks</b>	
A	Enter or edit the key label (maximum of 7 characters). To access special characters, press the Up Navigation Key. Use the Navigation Keys to locate the character you want to include. Press the Select Key to select the highlighted character. Press the Return Key to return to label entry without selecting a special character.
