In addition to being unsightly, the presence of algae in your pool also indicates that your pool likely harbours bacteria. The rapid removal of algae is paramount to ensuring a safe and comfortable swimming environment for you and your family.

Instructions

- 1 Have your water professionally tested and follow the recommendations.
- Your pool pump <u>must be</u> operating continuously on full speed and proper filtration must be occurring during this entire process.
- Balance your water as per our recommendations. Balanced water will increase the longevity of your pool surface and equipment and will aid in effectiveness of the following Algae Treatment steps.
- Add one bottle of **Omni Algae Terminator** directly to the pool water. This can be applied around the perimeter of the pool or in front of the return jets. Be careful not to spill or splash this product onto concrete or stone surfaces. If this occurs, promptly rinse off with fresh water.
- Thoroughly brush all pool surfaces. This will loosen algae and allow the treatment product to work as effectively as possible.
- Within one hour of the Omni Algae Terminator application, add one bottle of **Omni Swim Clear Granules**. This product must be applied into the skimmer. Improper application may result in bleaching of pool surfaces.
- 7 After 24 hours apply the second bottle of **Omni Swim Clear Granules** into the skimmer.
- Brush the pool surfaces. Inspect pool covers and handheld pool equipment for evidence of algae. If algae is present, these should be cleaned and then exposed to the treated pool water.
- Within 48 hours of the completion of step 7, the pool should turn a milky white colour. This means the algae has been destroyed. To easily remove the dead algae, add 1 bottle of **Pool First Aid** (sold separately) directly to the pool water. Continue to brush the pool daily. Ensure that your pool pump is operating at all times until the pool returns to sparkling clear. *If the water is still discoloured, further treatments may be required.*
- Return to have your water tested for phosphates and add the required product needed for removal. This will ensure that the algae will not return.
- It is always recommended to clean your filter after any algae treatment. To attain the best result from your filtration, please follow the label instructions for **Omni One Step Filter Cleaner** (sold separately) <u>after</u> the Algae Treatment has been completed.
