- 1. The following declaration states that the attorney has informed the client that he or she may elect relief under Chapter 7 or 13 of the bankruptcy Code.
- 2. The attorney is required to explain to the proposed debtor that he or she can and should consider a chapter 13 plan rather than the straight liquidation chapter 7.
- 3. The attorney should review the client's debts and advise the client of the provision in the bankruptcy code regarding consumer credit card debt and the chapter 13 considerations applicable thereto.
