

**Information & Instructions: Attorney's Affidavit Concerning Attorney's Fees In A Bankruptcy Petition**

**PREVIEW**

1. The following declaration states that the attorney has informed the client that he or she may elect relief under Chapter 7 or 13 of the bankruptcy Code.
2. The attorney is required to explain to the proposed debtor that he or she can and should consider a chapter 13 plan rather than the straight liquidation chapter 7.
3. The attorney should review the client's debts and advise the client of the provision in the bankruptcy code regarding consumer credit card debt and the chapter 13 considerations applicable thereto.
