Croppings of forested islands wrap around the country's perimeter, similar to the naturally gorgeous peppering of knots throughout this floor. European oak is beveled at all four edges to give this floor a classic wide-plank feel for a seamless look throughout your home.

DESCRIPTIONS & IMAGERY

Wood is a product of nature — each tree has its own structure and individual color combination. An image or a sample will therefore never be able to give you a complete picture of the finished floor. Please also note that the color may change when exposed to light. As a guideline, darker wood species will get a more golden tone, whereas lighter species will become slightly darker. Cracked knots are filled with putty, so small gaps between the putty and wood may appear.
