## DESCRIPTIONS \& IMAGERY

Wood is a product of nature - each tree has its own structure and individual color combination. An image or a sample will therefore never be able to give you a complete picture of the finished floor. Please also note that the color may change when exposed to light. As a guideline, darker wood species will get a more golden tone, whereas lighter species will become slightly darker. Cracked knots are filled with putty, so small gaps between the putty and wood may appear.
