1. Product Overview

A fixed cassette toilet designed for campervan conversions and off-grid travel. This unit features an enamel bowl, integrated 17L fresh water tank with manual flush, and a 24L waste tank that slides out for easy emptying. Ideal for self-contained certification setups where a permanent toilet solution is required.

- 2. What's in the Box
- Toilet unit (pre-assembled)
- 24L cassette tank with handle and pour spout
- Integrated 17L clean water tank
- 3. Installation Instructions

Tools required:

Screwdriver OR high-quality adhesive sealant (e.g. Sikaflex)

Installation steps:

- 1. Choose a flat, level surface within your van with adequate clearance for the rear cassette to slide out.
- 2. Orient the toilet to ensure access to the waste cassette from the vehicle exterior. Note: Side access door (UPC 23374 recommended) must be installed separately.
- 3. Fix the toilet base securely using either screws into the floor or adhesive suitable for plastic-to-floor bonding. It must be permanently fixed for Green Warrant certification.
- 4. Fill the clean water tank via the fill cap on top of the toilet.
- 5. Optionally connect to the main RV/caravan water supply via the provided fitting for press-button flushing.

We recommend professional installation by a qualified tradesperson or the Vanlifer team.

- 4. How to Use
- 5. Fill the clean water tank with fresh water.
- 6. Press the orange air release button to reduce pressure.
- 7. Open the slide valve before use.
- 8. Use the manual flush pump or press-button flush (if water supply connected) after each use.

- 9. Close the slide valve.
- 10. Monitor the waste level indicator when the red shows over halfway, it's time to empty.
- 11. To empty, remove the cassette via the exterior door, rotate the spout, press the air valve and pour.

Do not use harsh chemicals, and **always** wear gloves when emptying the cassette.

- 5. Maintenance & Cleaning
- Rinse the waste cassette thoroughly with clean water after each empty.
- Regularly clean the bowl with mild detergent and a soft brush.
- Ensure the slide valve opens/closes freely and seals properly.
- Store with the valve open to prevent pressure build-up or smell.
- 6. Safety & Compliance
- Do not exceed the 200kg max load.
- Keep children supervised.
- Only use approved toilet chemicals if needed.
- Ensure cassette is fully seated and latched before use.

Improper installation may void your warranty.

For fixed toilets in campervans, compliance with NZS 5465 (Self-Containment Standard) is strongly advised.

7. Troubleshooting

Issue: Flush not working

- Check water level in tank.
- Inspect manual pump or push-button for blockage.

Issue: Waste tank hard to remove

• Ensure slide valve is fully closed.

Issue: Bad smell

Cassette may be overdue for emptying. Rinse thoroughly.
