### **USER MANUAL**

#### \* DSP CONTROLS

- 1. Turn the LINE/MP3 VOL knob to adjust the LINE/MP3 volume.
- 2. Push and hold the knob for 3 seconds to mute.
- 3. Push the knob to enter the LCD DSP controls menu.
- Turn the knob to scroll through the DSP menu.
- Push the knob to select the menu item you want to modify.
- Turn and push the knob to confirm the settings of selected items.
- Repeat to modify additional DSP settings.
- 4. Return to MP3 player interface automatically after 5 seconds.
