




- The DST 50 can be mounted into 2 different configurations:
 - Mount onto a C-Stand. The DST 50 does not come with a C-Stand.
 - Mount onto a table/desk using the supplied Table Clamp (B)

Table/Desk configuration:




- Mount the Table Clamp (B) to the table or desk you would like to use by tightening the screw at the bottom of the clamp as shown in Fig.1.
- Slide the Main Telescopic Pole (A) onto the peg on top of the Table Clamp (B).
- Using the Locking Screw (D), secure the Main Telescopic Pole (A) to the peg as in shown in Fig. 2.



C-Stand configuration:



- Slide the Main Telescopic Pole (A) onto your C-Stand as in Fig. 3.
- Using the Locking Screw (D), secure the Main Telescopic Pole (A) to the C-Stand.




Adjust the height of the Main Telescopic (A) by loosening and tightening the pole clamp connecting the 2 telescopic poles as shown in Fig. 4.





- Connect the Telescopic Arm (C) via the Main Hinge (E) as in shown in Fig. 4.
- Adjust the angle of the Telescopic Arm (C) by loosening and tightening the Main Hinge (E).
 - Make sure the Main Hinge (E) is fully locked before moving to the next step.



Adjust the length of the Telescopic Arm (C) by loosening and tightening the clamp connecting the poles (Fig. 5).



Adjust the angle of the Camera Platform (F) by loosening and tightening the hinge connecting the Camera Platform (C) to the Telescopic Arm (C). See Fig. 5.



Make sure all the joints are fully locked into position.

Mount your camera to the Camera Platform (F).



Once assembled, your setup should look like below:
