To round off the last week of April college baseball, many of PTA's alumni had good weeks! Let's take a look at some of their highlights:

OWEN RICE (UW-Milwaukee) tossed 2.1 innings and struck out 6 batters. This season, Owen has 34 strikeouts in just 24.1 innings of work!

JACOB HARTLAUB (Ball State University) had two pitching appearances and earned 3 strikeouts.

MITCHELL CRAWLEY (UW-Stevens Point) threw 3 innings and allowed 0 earned runs. This season, Mitchell leads the team in appearances on the mound, while averaging a strikeout per inning!

Representing UW-Stevens Point, **COLTON MARTELL** went 3 for 4 with 2 homeruns and 4 RBIs in a game this week, while **ANTHONY TOMCZAK** was 11 for 28 with 3 doubles and 1 homerun. This season, Anthony leads the Pointers in at bats, hits, and doubles!
