ETHAN SAWYER of Upper Iowa University continued his hot streak, batting 8 for 14 with 8 runs and 4 RBIs. With a hitting streak now at 8 games, Sawyer boasts an impressive .337 batting average for the season, while also drawing 14 walks, demonstrating both consistency and productivity at the plate for the Peacocks.

KYLE SAGAN representing Edgewood College also delivered a stellar performance, going 9 for 21 with 2 doubles and driving in 7 runs across 6 games.

For Ohio Dominican University, **GIANNI PASSARELLI** extended his hitting streak to 7 games by batting 4 for 11 with 2 doubles and 2 RBIs, showcasing his ability to consistently contribute to the Panthers success.

KEEGAN MCCARTY of McKendree University turned heads with a career-high 9 strikeouts over 4 innings pitched.

For the UW-Milwaukee Panthers, **OWEN RICE** showcased his durability, tossing a career-high 5.1 innings while recording 4 strikeouts.

NATE SNEAD representing the University of Tennessee made a significant impact out of the bullpen, notching 1 save across 2 appearances while tallying 3 strikeouts over 4.1 innings pitched.

NOLAN HODGINS of Wisconsin Lutheran College made his presence felt with a standout performance, going 3 for 4 at the plate, including a homerun and 3 RBIs, while also displaying patience with 2 walks.

For the Pointers of UW-Stevens Point, **MITCH CRAWLEY** demonstrated his effectiveness in closing out games, securing a win with just 4 pitches in a brief but impactful outing. Additionally, **ANTHONY TOMCZAK** secured a hit, an RBI, and 2 walks.

JACOB HARTLAUB of Ball State University earned a win on the mound, striking out 3 batters over 4.1 innings pitched.

Representing Edgewood College, **CONNOR GOODWIN** came through in the clutch with an RBI double.
