There are three main categories of governments: Democracy, Hybrid, or Authoritarian (Autocracy).

Democracy: Allows citizens to vote and hold power in government.

Hybrid: Citizens have some voting rights but not full power.

Authoritarian: Citizens are powerless and cannot vote.

Brown- single party state

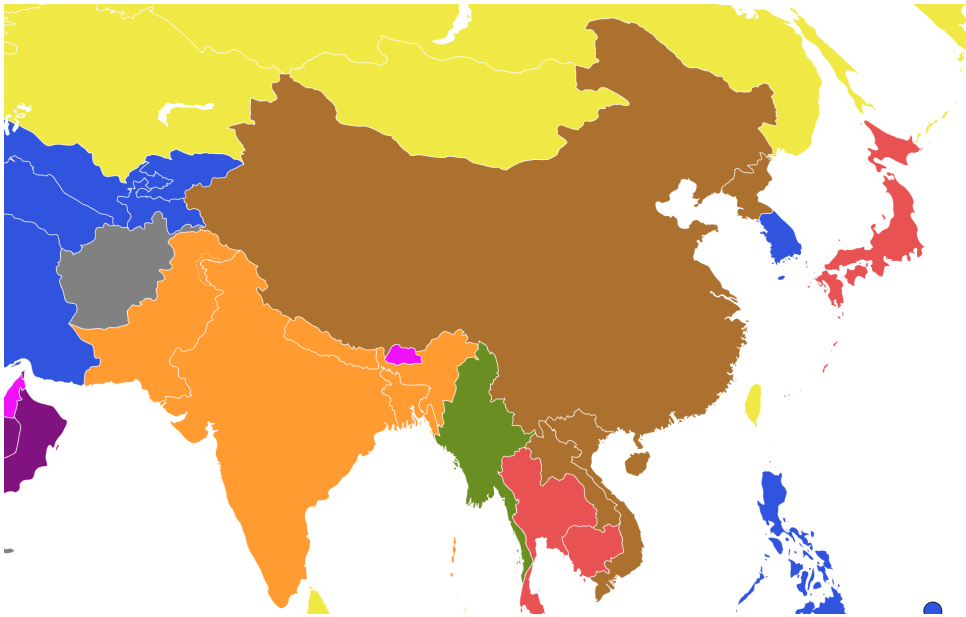
Orange- parliamentary republic

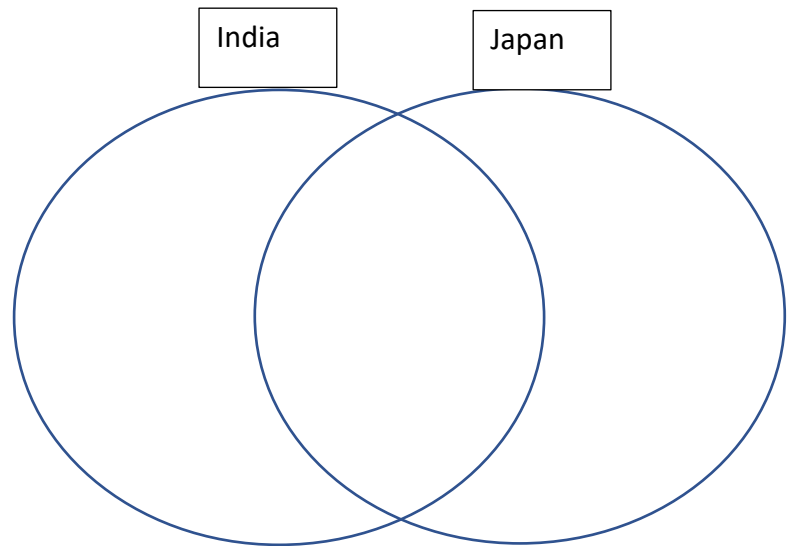
