

Quietizing your System

We have done LOTS of work with "Quietizing" systems over the past few years.. for "Quietizing"..

start with a rubber mat on the floor, and walls in enclosed trailers & boxTrucks. Everything with an engine should be bolted down with vibration isolators, ..or the whole trailer "radiates" noise as with the induction coil of a speaker.

with our secondary silencer on the blower, a secondary silencer on the motor, there's NO exhaust noise, so adding the blower wrap reduces "radiated noise" off the blower. It is rubber mat with a special heat-proof sound-deadening fiber.

Between the blower-wrap and the secondary-silencers, your system will be WAY quieter than your competition, and for more.. adding panels around the system would be next. but a bigger jump in cost.
