#### Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the BIOS Living Ultra Slim Glass Scale. This Scale was developed with state-of-the-art electronics; this precision device has a capacity of 350 lbs / 158 kg, and is equipped with an auto power ON/OFF function, auto zero reset.

#### **Features**

## Starting your Scale

- I. The lithium battery (CR2032) is **included** with your bath scale. Remove the battery cover from the back of the scale, by lifting the black tab. Remove protective film from battery and close the battery cover.
- 2. Before starting the scale, change the unit of measurement. On the back of the scale there is a small button labeled "KG/LB/ST". Press the button to choose the desired measurement.

#### Operation

- I. Place the scale on a hard, flat surface (avoid carpet or other soft surfaces). **NOTE:** If the scale is placed on a soft surface, such as a carpet, the results may be inaccurate or an error message may occur.
- 2. Step onto the scale slowly and gently (do not jump onto the scale). Stand vertically without swaying and place your feet evenly apart.

**NOTE:** If the display shows "C", this is an indication of an inaccurate reading. If this occurs repeat step 2.

- 3. Your weight will be displayed on the screen; it will flash three times and then stop at your correct weight.

  4. Step off the scale, a new user can use the scale immediately afterwards.
- 5. The scale will automatically turn off after 8 seconds when not in use.

# Troubleshooting

Error Displayed	Reason for Error
Lo	Indicates low battery
oL	If the scale is overloaded - Over capacity (350 lbs / 158 kg) remove weight immediately from scale
Nothing is displayed on the screen	Replace the battery

### Advice for Use and Care

- Avoid using platform when wet platform will be slippery when wet. Keep scale dry.
- Avoid an extremely high or low temperature environment.
- Avoid excessive impact or vibration to the unit.
- Clean the scale with a damp cloth and avoid water getting inside scale.
- Remove battery when the scale is not being used for long periods of time.
- Store scale in horizontal position.
