1. The committee will evaluate the candidates on high school grades, other achievements and community service.
2. Evaluation is based on scores allotted for a combination of financial need, scholastic scores and candidate's extracurricular achievements and community service activities.
3. The committee will contact you for any further information if needed.
4. The candidate must be accepted in an undergraduate college in Georgia, USA.
5. Attach a copy of parents' IRS certified transcript of the Federal Income Tax Form 1040.
6. The candidate may be asked about other scholarship and assistance receiving from other sources.

General Guidelines for awards:

1. The applicant must be a Hindu.
2. The recipients of the awards will be decided by the sole direction of the Committee based on above guidelines and the Judges' decisions are final.
3. It is mandatory to claim the award in person at the annual scholarship meeting of The Hindu Temple of Atlanta. Failure to do so will result in the award being given to the next deserving candidate.
4. The applicant must commit to perform at least 100 hours of volunteer service at The Hindu Temple of Atlanta during the academic year 2019/2020.
