

CHRISTMAS SPARKLE

Festive Foliage class checklist:

Make sure you have everything needed for this Master Class.

Chef Nicholas Lodge

Sugar:

- 40g / No.15 size ball of foliage green FlexiPaste or match colour to *The Measuring Mould* formula for foliage green
- 25g / No.14 size ball of blue spruce or match colour to *The Measuring Mould* formula for dusty miller

Air Drying Clay:

- 4 x balls of foliage green using *The Measuring Mould* formula:
No.1 white + No.4 green + No.4 yellow + No.3 orange
- 3 x balls of dusty miller green using *The Measuring Mould* formula:
No.1 White + No.6 Green + No.7 Dark Green + No.10 Blue

Wires:

French Tulip Leaf Bow

- 2 x half length 22 gauge white or green wires
- 2 x full length 22 gauge white or green wires
- 1 x half length 20 gauge white or green wire for assembly

English Boxwood

- 6x full length 30 gauge green wires
- 1x half length 22 gauge white or green wire for assembly

Spruce

- 3 x half length 24 gauge white or green wires
- 1 x half length 20 gauge white or green wire for assembly

Floral tape:

- Half width light green floral tape
- Quarter width light green floral tape
- Half width brown floral tape

Moulds:

- Flower Pro Calla Lily & Tulip Leaf Mould
- Flower Pro Wedding Foliage Mould
- Flower Pro Winter Foliage Mould

Dusting powders:

- Apple green
- Foliage green
- Chocolate
- Pale chocolate
- White (for ADC use white acrylic paint)

Plus:

- Vodka
- 200-225g leftover / scraps / odd colours mixed together of sugar paste or rolled fondant, or 2cm slice of Styrofoam or foam for dry flower arrangement.
- Sand or fine grain like quinoa, coarse cornmeal, etc.
- Fake snow / fake glitter snow
- Metallic foam vase fillers
- Christmas baubles foam, plastic or glass, fake winter / glitter twigs, rhinestone hat pins / hair pins, brooches as desired.
