MDF Floating Frames: How to assemble

Use these contemporary frames to display paper cutting, pressed flowers, pictures and photos – your artwork is pressed between two clear acrylic sheets, giving the illusion of floating inside the picture frame. Made from premium MDF and Acrylic, they can be embellished and painted in a variety of mediums.



Carefully remove the protective film from the front and back of both acrylic sheets.



Place your chosen artwork between the two acrylic sheets and set aside.



Apply glue to the middle layer of the frame and attach to the back layer of the frame, to create an inlay.



Take the acrylic sheets with your artwork sandwiched between and place into the frame inlay.



Apply glue to the top layer of the frame and stick down, gently pressing to secure all layers of the frame together.



Fold the MDF picture hook and glue together. Glue to the back of your frame. Allow to dry, hang and enjoy.
