## On Practice Test day, here's what you need to do before 2am Eastern Time (United States):

1. Call into conference call with your phone before logging into test.

2. Open the Pearson Browser already downloaded to student computer.

3. Wait for proctor to begin call.

4. Enter session number proctor gives you on conference call.

5. Log in with the student's name and birthday or the ID number. \*space and case sensitive

Once all have logged into practice test, proctor will give further instructions prior to approving students into the practice test.

\*grades 10-12 need to be on the call for technical check and instructions, but will be dismissed prior to practice test. Entire process takes approximately 1 hour for grades 3-9.
