

The Method. Danish Soap Finish.



5 MIN.

This is a traditional woodworkers finish that has been used by woodworkers for centuries, and continues to be the preferred finishing method of a number of master woodworkers.

Re-wax whenever the luster of the wood begins to wane, or when it looks “dry.”

What to Avoid.

Liquids



Overexposure

In this demo, we will walk you through how to clean up a ring stain, however, the same method can be followed for any superficial damage to your piece.

1.

To clean an average ring stain, mix 1 tablespoon of soap flakes with 1 tablespoon of water. Mix until you reach a stiff, meringue-like consistency. This may take up to 3 minutes.

2.

Using a cloth rag and following the grain, apply wax to the buffed area until it matches the color of the finished wood.

3.

With the sandpaper, evenly smooth the wax across the surface of the work area. Let the wax dry for a few minutes.

Using a clean piece of sandpaper, go over the wax once more. To finish, wipe the surface down with a dry cloth . rag to make sure it is dry and smooth.
