
3. Secure the mounting panel with unit under the table using provided screws 3/4" long. Use screws as specified on labels in the plastic bags provided in the kit. The mounting screws that are provided with the unit should not be used on tables less than 3/4" thick.





Close unit. Remove top protection layer of both adhesive strips. Place the wooden cover over the top cover with adhesive strips.

> 5. Align the wooden cover so that the space around the wooden cover is symmetrical. If the space is not equal from first try, peel the wooden cover off and try again, untill it is aligned perfectly.








To adjust and align the unit to the surface of the table, simply:

- 1. Close the unit. 2. Loosen all four wing nuts under the table.
- 3. Press the unit down or upwards from below the desk until it aligns with the surface of the desk. 4. And tighten the wing nuts below the desk.







