Derek Reed's wife started working from home in 2019 and was using a small table and chair for a workspace. Derek felt she needed a better office area, and so decided to build her a custom desk. "I used ProMarine Epoxy with live edge cedar wood with river rocks, along with some stickers to decorate the rocks, and sealed the entire piece in epoxy resin."





Feeling inspired, Derek also, coated her credenza with epoxy and, added rifle and pistol shells in the resin as accent pieces. He explains, "For the aqua marine color, I used a turquoise metallic powder. The drawer pulls are pieces from deer antlers, and then I used some pieces of pipe to attach to the underside of the desk to be able to mount two deer heads on both sides of the front – giving it a rustic homey motif."





His wife also wanted her Mickey Mouse accents on the credenza, so Derek made three easels out of Cedar post - stripping the bark off - and using a torch to for the detail. "I now have a Happy Wife & Happy Life!"
