Form submissions for show must be in by June 8, 2019 5pm. All art work must be brought to the museum no later than 6/13/19 5pm.

1. This submission form MUST be signed by every artist who participated in the creation of the art piece. A guardian must also sign. If more than one artist use back of form for name and signature.
2. By signing this form you acknowledge: (1) YOUR SUBMISSION IS AN ORIGINAL CONCEPT AND EXECUTION AND IS NOT A COPY OR REPRODUCTION OF THE ARTS OF ANOTHER; AND (2) YOU IRREVOCABLY GRANT To NASW Aviation Museum the right to display your art until Sept 3, 2019. (3) You hold NASW Aviation Museum, its employees, volunteers and/or board members free from any damage that might accrue while displaying in museum.
3. Your submission should include this form, a high resolution (min 300dpi or higher) digital file on a USB or a picture of your art piece for board approval. Must be clear and completely shown.
4. There is no fee for submitting art piece. 1 submission piece per student allowed.
5. Guardian, by signing this form you agree to all rules and regulations and are allowing your student to participate.

How to Enter

Form submissions for show must be in by June 1, 2019 5pm. All art work must be brought to the museum no later than 6/13/19 5pm. There is no fee to submit a piece.

Guidelines, Notification, and Delivery

Students may submit only ONE artwork. Entries may be submitted through a public, private, or home school teacher or instructor of an art program. Verification required.

The exhibition is open to all K-12 students. Art must be original and completed within the current 2019-2020 school year. Original works in all 2D media including drawings, paintings, photographs, fiber, and collages are eligible. You may call office to see if your art piece qualifies if you are unsure.

Dimensions of 2D work must not be more than 36 inches in any direction and must weigh less than 50 lbs.

Collaborative projects may be submitted as a single entry. A collaborative project is defined as an artwork made by a group of students who work together towards the final product. A group of individuals' works brought together using a display aid does not qualify.

Notifications of selected artwork will be sent prior to board approval. All art work must be brought to the museum no later than 6/13/19 5pm.

Digital Images

Artworks are selected for the exhibition based on the digital image submissions. Images should be clear and show the entire artwork. Medium resolution images are preferred. Resolution is sufficient when the image is easily viewed on an average size computer monitor. Keep images free of identifying information (artist name, etc.) as this information will require cropping of the image. Entry forms and picture can be emailed to barbara.nasw@gmail.com only. She will not be voting.

Awards

Art pieces will be selected for the exhibition by board members. They will select works based on the uploaded images from the entry form. Once all artworks are delivered to the NASW Museum, a grand juror consisting of artists, board members and employees of NASW Foundation on June 14, 2019 will vote on pieces. They will select the following awards: 1- Best In Class for each age category 1- (k-3rd), 2-(4th-7th,) 3-(8th-12th), 2- Honorable Mentions for each category, and The Salvatore Family distinguish honor award for overall best. We will put names on all art works after voting is complete. Award ceremony will be June 16th, 2019 at 1:00pm in Hangar by art exhibit.

RETURNING! All art work can be picked up between June 17-23. Any work left after the 23rd will be property of NASW Foundation. If you should need a little longer to pick up art, please send in email your request date to barbara.nasw@gmail.com Winner's art will be returned after September 3rd when our Airfest event is over. We will be displaying it till then.
