

Constellation Connect Nest[®] Plugin Setup and User Guide

Your Constellation Connect system can connect to thousands of additional smart home devices*, including the Nest Learning Thermostat[™] and Nest Protect[™] smoke + carbon monoxide alarm. Adding your Nest products to your Constellation Connect system is simple and can be completed in minutes.

Once your Nest products are integrated into your Connect system, you'll be able to control them from your Connect app and incorporate them into scenes and modes. Plus, with the Constellation Connect Alexa skill, you can control your Nest Thermostat by voice.



What is a scene? Scenes are customized device actions that are triggered by a defined action, e.g. a device status change, a schedule or a geofence location.

What is a mode? Modes are predefined, but configurable settings that change when you set your system status to Home, Armed Away, Armed Stay or Vacation.

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Adding Nest Products to Your Constellation Connect System

It's easy to add your existing Nest Thermostat and Nest Protect smoke + carbon monoxide alarm to your Constellation Connect system. Before you begin, make sure your Nest product(s) are already installed and that you have a Nest account with access to your login credentials.

To start connecting, install the “Works With Nest” plugin to your Connect system following the instructions below:

1 In the **Device Wizard** screen, select **Thermostats** under **Additional Devices**.

2 In the **Thermostats** list, select **Nest Thermostat**.

3 In the **Device Wizard** screen, select **Install**.

4 The **Device Wizard** screen shows a loading spinner.

5 In the main app interface, select **Connect Works W..**


6 In the **Connect Works W..** configuration screen, select **Authorize**.

TIP: You'll need to log in to your Constellation Connect account using your mobile or PC web browser to complete the setup of your Nest plugin.

Adding Nest Products to Your Constellation Connect System

Now that the “Works With Nest” plugin has been installed, you will need to authorize and authenticate your Connect system by logging into your Nest account.




Using Your Nest Products in Constellation Connect

Once your Nest products are connected to your Constellation Connect system, you'll be able to control them and incorporate them into scenes and modes.

If you have the Constellation Connect Alexa skill set, you'll also be able to control your thermostat with your voice.

You can change your Nest Thermostat mode between Heating, Cooling, Eco mode and Off.

You can also change the temperature set points.



You can also create scenes or customize your modes to include your Nest Thermostat. For example, you can set your Nest Thermostat for Eco mode when your home is in Vacation mode.
