## CLEAT REMOVAL & INSTALLATION GUIDE





Remove your old cleats with a Softspikes® CleatKaddy,™ Cleat Ripper,™ or Champ® MaxPro Wrench by twisting the cleats counter-clockwise until they come out of the receptacle. Remove excess debris from the receptacle.

Make sure you have the appropriate replacement cleats to match the recepatcles in your shoes. Then, follow the instructions for your Insert System below.

Note: installing the wrong cleat into a mis-matched receptacle can permanently damage the receptacle. Do not attempt to force the cleats into the receptacles... check for obstructions and make sure you are installing the correct cleats.









For Fast Twist® 3.0, Tour Lock,™ and Slim-LOK® cleats, thread the cleat into the receptacle by hand and twist until it clicks 1 time. **Proceed to Step #3A.** 

NOTE: Do not attempt to install Fast Twist® or Tri-LOK® cleats into Fast Twist® 3.0/Tour Lock™ or Slim-LOK® receptacles (the small pin in Fast Twist® 3.0/Tour Lock™ or Slim-LOK® receptacles will prevent installation).









For Fast Twist® and Tri-LOK® cleats, thread the cleat into the receptacle by hand and twist until it clicks 1 time. **Proceed to Step #3B.** 

NOTE: Fast Twist® 3.0/Tour Lock™ or Slim-LOK® cleats <u>will</u> fit in Fast Twist® or Tri-LOK® receptacles.







For PINS® cleats, align the cleat to fit in the receptacle, and place it in by

hand. Do not attempt to hand-tighten. **Proceed to Step #3C.** 








For Q-LOK® cleats, align the cleat to fit in the receptacle, and place it in by

hand. Do not attempt to hand-tighten. **Proceed to Step #3D.** 





Metal Thread Insert System

For Metal Thread cleats, thread the cleat into the receptacle and

hand-tighten just enough so that the cleat stays in place. **Proceed to Step #3E.** 





Using a Softspikes<sup>®</sup> CleatKaddy,<sup>™</sup> Cleat Ripper,<sup>™</sup> or Champ<sup>®</sup> MaxPro Wrench,<sup>™</sup> follow the instructions below for your specific Insert System/Cleats.

- A. For Fast Twist® 3.0/Tour Lock™ and Slim-LOK,® cleats, use the wrench to turn the cleat clockwise until it clicks 1 additional time, locking the cleat into place.
- B. For Fast Twist® and Tri-LOK® cleats, use the wrench to turn the cleat clockwise until it clicks 2 additional times, locking the cleat into place.
- **C. For PINS® cleats**, use the wrench to turn the cleat clockwise until it **clicks** <u>3 times</u>, locking the cleat into place.
- **D. For Q-LOK® cleats**, use the wrench to turn the cleat clockwise until it **clicks** 1 time, locking the cleat into place.
- **E. For Small Metal Thread cleats**, use the wrench to turn the cleat clockwise until the cleat is flush with the sole of the shoe, locking the cleat into place. *Do not to over-tighten.*
