IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using this electrical appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed:


- 1. Read all instructions.
- Before use, please make sure that the service voltage corresponds to 220-240V ~50/60Hz, in order to avoid damaging the appliance.
- The unit belongs to Class 1 appliance. Make sure the unit is properly grounded. In the event of malfunction or breakdown, grounding will reduce the risk of electric shock by providing a path of least resistance for electric current.
- 4. Do not operate any appliance with a damage cord or plug or after the appliance malfunction or has been damaged in any manner. Return the appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair or adjustment.
- 5. The use of attachments, including juice strainer and food pusher, not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a heated oven.
- 7. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- 8. Please operate the unit on a horizontal workbench. Do not operate it on an inclined or unstable workbench or surfaces such as carpets or towels. Keep the unit away from the edges of a workbench or table in order to prevent injuries or damage to the unit.
- 9. Never run the appliance without food inside.
- Do not put your fingers or other objects into the feeding chute while juicer is in operation. If food becomes lodged in

the feeding chute, use food pusher or another piece of fruit or vegetable to push it down. When this method is not possible, turn the motor off and disassemble juicer to remove the remaining food.

- 11. Avoid contact with moving parts.
- 12. Make sure the unit is switched off after each use. Make sure the motor stops completely before disassembling.
- 13. Do not immerse the main body in water or other liquid.
- 14. All detachable parts must be dried completely after cleaning, and then assembled into the appliance for next usage.
- 15. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 16. Always disconnect the juicer from the power supply if it is left unattended and before assembling, disassembling or cleaning.
- 17. This appliance shall not be used by children. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
- 18. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.
- 19. Do not use outdoors.
- 20. This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses;
 - by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments.

BEFORE FIRST USE


- 1. Unpack the appliance and place all parts on a flat surface.
- Immerse all the detachable parts and accessories in warm soapy water and rinse them and dry. (To disassemble, see section HOW TO DISASSEMBLE AND CLEAN)
 - **WARNING!** *Never immerse main body in water to prevent the risk of electric shock.*
- 3. Before assembling, ensure that the power cord is unplugged from the power supply.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

- 1. Align feeding chute frame and main body. Turn feeding chute counterclockwise from the \blacksquare to the \square position until the lock button clicks.
- 2. Align the shaft of the ceramic juicing screw with the hole in the feeding chute frame, then push the juicing screw into place.
- 3. Slide the juicing strainer over the ceramic juicing screw.
- 4. Align mark on end cap to mark on feeding chute frame. Turn end cap counterclockwise until mark on end cap is aligned with the mark on the feeding chute frame.
- 5. Finally, place containers under the juice outlet and pulp outlet.

HOW TO OPERATE

- 1. Insert the power plug into an outlet. Open the juice outlet cover.
- 2. Choose your desired juice texture using the pulp control selector on the end cap.



Note: Do not adjust the pulp control selector while the unit is in operation.

- 3. Press the START/STOP button. Insert cut fruits or vegetables into the feeding chute, a few pieces at a time. If the pieces are too big for the rotating lid, flip it to drop the pieces inside the chute. Use the food pusher to push the fruit or vegetables gently down the chute. Leave the unit running as you feed in the ingredients.
 - Feed ingredients little by little and at a slow pace, allowing all the pulp to extract. Do not force or overstuff.
 - Use the food pusher when food becomes stuck.
 - If becomes lodged in the feeding chute, a beeping sound will be heard and the unit will automatically operate in reverse for a few seconds before coming to a stop. Press START/STOP button to resume the juicing operation.

4. After extraction is completed, press START/STOP and close the juice outlet cover. Unplug unit from outlet.

Note: The unit has a protection chip and will automatically stop after 15 minutes of continuous operation. Wait for about 20-30 minutes to let the motor cool down before using the unit again.

JUICING TIPS


- 1. Choose fresh fruits and vegetables with higher water content, such as apples, pears, pineapple, watermelon, citrus fruits, carrots, tomatoes, and cucumbers.
- 2. Cut fruit into pieces small enough to fit the feeding chute opening.
- Peel the thick skin and remove large and/or hard seeds and stones from fruits such as mangoes and pineapples. Leave the skin on apples.
- 4. Fresh apple juice turns brown quickly because of oxidation. This can be slowed down by adding a few drops of lemon juice.
- 5. Leafy vegetables with stems can also be used with the slow juicer.
- Soft, fleshy fruits such as bananas, papayas, avocado, and mangoes are more suitable for blenders.
- 7. Seeds, nuts, beans, and corn need to be fresh or soaked in water before using with the slow juicer.
- 8. Mix with fruits when juicing leafy greens for optimal results.
- 9. Do not feed pulp into the juicer for re-extraction.

HOW TO DISASSEMBLE AND CLEAN

- 1. Turn feeding chute assembly clockwise from the $\widehat{\blacksquare}$ to the $\widehat{\blacksquare}$ position until the lock button clicks.
- 2. Remove the end cap from the feeding chute assembly, followed by the juice strainer, then the ceramic juicing screw.
- Wash the juice and pulp containers, feeding chute, food pusher, ceramic juicing screw, juice strainer, and end cap in warm soapy water. Use the supplied cleaning brush to clean the parts thoroughly.

Note: Move the pulp control selector back and forth to facilitate removal of pulp inside the end cap.

- 4. Wipe main body with a soft, damp or dry cloth.
- 5. Dry all parts thoroughly.



STORAGE

- 1. To avoid formation of rust, dry the parts thoroughly after washing.
- 2. Store juicer in a dry, well-ventilated place beyond the reach of children. Avoid direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Juicer does not run after power is switched on	Power plug is not plugged	Insert power plug into an outlet
	Feeding chute assembly is not attached to the main body correctly	Make sure feeding chute assembly is properly attached
	Circuit breaker protection is activated: Unsuitable ingredients used; volume of ingredients too big	Use suitable ingredients and do not overstuff the juicer
The juicer suddenly stops	Intelligent protection chip is activated; operating time is longer than the rated duration	Follow the rated duration (15 minutes). To resume operation, please wait for 20-30 minutes before turning on the unit again.
	Feeding chute assembly is jammed	Press Reverse button to loosen the jammed ingredients. Or remove the feeding chute assembly and take out the ingredients causing the jam.
Abnormal noise and vibration during operation The feeding chute assembly parts are not installed and assembled correctly		Make sure the feeding chute assembly is properly installed and in place.

Juice is leaking from the slow juicer	The juice outlet cover is open Feeding chute assembly is not assembled properly	Close the juice outlet cover. Assemble parts correctly.
