




STOPBOXE

Thank you for purchasing the StopBox® Handgun Retention Device. Before using the StopBox® please read carefully all the warnings and safety precautions included in this manual.

The StopBox® Handgun Retention Device is designed to conceal and prevent unintended access while your firearm is not on your body or in the safe. This is the in between while your firearm is still in use.

SPECIFICATIONS

- Polycarbonate-ABS construction

- Padlock compatible

You should seek proper firearm safety training before owning and using a firearm.

Never leave a loaded firearm unattended.

The StopBox® is intended for retaining your firearm, aiding in restricting immediate unintentional access and is not intended to be left unattended.

Never allow children to play with or handle the StopBox®.

The StopBox® is NOT a safe. You shall determine the suitability of the StopBox® to your specific situation and needs.

Regularly inspect the StopBox® for damage or wear. If the StopBox® is damaged or not functioning properly stop using immediately and replace it.

CAUTION: Many lubricant additives will attack plastic materials causing cracking and failure. If you need to lubricate the StopBox® we recommend using Super Lube® Multi-Purpose Synthetic Grease.

ALWAYS follow the four rules of gun safety.

Treat every gun as if it is loaded, even if it is not.

Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.

Never point a gun at something you are not willing to destroy.

Always know your target and what is beyond it.

UNLOCKING

- 1. Place the StopBox® on a solid flat surface.
- 2. Index your hand on the corner of the enclosure and align your fingers with the 5 finger actuators.
- 3. Press and hold the ring and index finger actuators simultaneously. **NOTE:** pinning the StopBox® down with your palm will keep it from moving.
- 4. While applying downward pressure on the lid press the thumb actuator fully and lift open.

Remember, there is a lid pressure safety. You must press the lid down to unlock the StopBox®.

LOCKING

Make sure any contents are within the inside barriers then firmly press the center of the enclosure until you hear it lock shut. **NOTE:** If the StopBox® will not close, press the lockbar release button while pressing your combination until the lockbar goes into the unlocked position, then try again.

CHANGING THE COMBINATION

Open your StopBox® and press the lockbar release button. Remove the screw from the finger actuator you'd like to change. Then replace with a different number actuator.

Number Key, actuator will unlock when:

- 1 = not pressed
- 2 = halfway pressed
- 3 = fully pressed

Once finished, press the lockbar release button again while pressing your combination, then close.
