

Brush Care

We recommend you wash your brushes with Paint Pixie Suds Brush Soap when using water based paint.

I-With warm water rinse out as much paint or wax from your brush.

2-Wet the soap and the bag.

3-Scrub your brush in a back and forth motion, or your wax brush in a circular motion.

4-Rinse and repeat until ALL the paint or wax is out of your brush. Squeeze out the excess water.

5-Natural bristles can frizz just like our hair. If you wrap your brushes in a paper towel and let them dry, they will dry back to their original shape.

6-Hang with the bristles down or lay flat to dry. It's best not to let the water drain back into the ferrule (metal) as it may rust. It may also weaken the glue that holds the bristles, nails and ferrule together.

NOTE: We recommend to NEVER let your brushes soak in water past the ferrule. Soaking may cause the bristles and nails to fall out.

By taking good care of your brushes you increase the longevity of your brushes! Happy Painting!
