



Safety Warnings

• Before use, please read the user manual and safety warnings carefully, and make sure you understand and accept all the safety instructions. The user will be responsible for any loss or damage caused by improper use.

Before each cycle of operation, the operator shall perform the preoperation checks specified by the manufacturer. That all guards and

1. Get Started

11 Attaching the Seat

• FLIP SEAT RIGHT SIDE UP AND MAKE SURE TO PLACE ON A SOFT SURFACE. ALIGN FRAME TO MATCH BOLT HOLES. • PLACE WASHER (**B**) ONTO BOLT (**A**) AND THREAD BOLT INTO THE HOLE UNTIL FAIRLY TIGHT.

• REPEAT USING REMAINING 3 BOLTS AND 3 WASHERS.

• TIGHTEN WITH PROVIDED WRENCH.

NOTE: BE CAREFUL NOT TO OVER-TIGHTEN THE BOLTS. DOING SO MAY CAUSE THE SEAT TO CRACK.



• MAKE SURE SEAT IS SECURELY ATTACHED.



1.2 Inserting the Brackets

- INSERT RIGHT BRACKET INTO RIGHT SIDE OF THE REAR HORIZONTAL AXIS.
- SCREW BRACKET IN PLACE USING BOLT (D).
- INSERT LEFT BRACKET INTO LEFT SIDE OF THE REAR HORIZONTAL AXIS.
- SCREW BRACKET IN PLACE USING BOLT.

NOTE: BE CAREFUL NOT TO OVER-TIGHTEN THE BOLTS. DOING SO MAY CAUSE THE BRACKETS TO CRACK.





1.3 Attaching the Nose Cap

• SNAP NOSE CAP ONTO FRONT PLATE OF REMIX. • SCREW (C1) NOSE CAP INTO PLACE VIA THE UNDERSIDE OF THE FRAME. NOSE CAP

NOTE: DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE NOSE CAP. DOING SO MAY CAUSE THE NOSE CAP TO CRACK.



1.4 Inserting the Footrests

- INSERT FOOTREST INTO EACH SIDE OF THE FRONT TUBE ON THE REMIX FRAME.
- ALIGN FOOTREST WITH SCREW HOLES ON THE FRONT TUBE.
- USING THE SMALL SCREW (C2) SUPPLIED, SCREW PEDALS IN PLACE.



• MAKE SURE FOOTREST ARE SECURELY IN PLACE.



1.5 Adjusting the Footrest

OPEN CLAMP, THEN LOOSEN KNOBS.

NOTE: OVEREXTENDING THE FOOTREST CAN CAUSE THE FRONT WHEEL TO SHAKE.

SLIDE THE FOOTREST TUBES TO DESIRED LENGTH


- SECURE FOOTREST IN PLACE BY CLOSING CLAMPS.
- FINALLY, TIGHTEN KNOBS.



1.6 Attaching the Hoverboard

 MAKE SURE SIDE OF HOVERBOARD WITH CHARGING PORT IS FACING OUT. HOVERBOARD MUST BE TURNED OFF BEFORE PLACING REMIX ON TOP OF IT.








• MAKE SURE HOVERBOARD IS SECURELY IN PLACE.

1.7 Charging the Hoverboard

- ONLY USE THE INCLUDED CHARGER
- PLUG THE CHARGER INTO THE WALL BEFORE THE CHARGING PORT
- DON'T TURN ON THE REMIX HOVERBOARD WHILE IT'S CHARGING
- CHARGE THE BATTERY UNTIL IT IS FULLY CHARGED UP TO 4 HOURS



1.8 Indicator Lights


1.10 Recalibrating the Hoverboard



• PLACE POWERED OFF HOVERBOARD ON A FLAT SURFACE. HOLD THE POWER BUTTON FOR 5 SECONDS UNTIL TUNE IS COMPLETED.

- LET GO OF POWER BUTTON AND THEN PRESS IT AGAIN TO TURN HOVERBOARD OFF.
- TURN HOVERBOARD BACK ON; RECALIBRATION IS NOW COMPLETE.

* KEEP THE HOVERBOARD LEVELED, STILL, AND WITHOUT ANY WEIGHT ON IT DURING THE CALIBRATION PROCESS.



1.11 Turning the Lights On

- LEVEL THE SEAT AND HOVERBOARD BEFORE CONNECTING THE SEAT WIRE TO THE HOVERBOARD'S CHARGING PORT.
- MAKE SURE SIDE OF HOVERBOARD WITH CHARGING PORT IS FACING OUT.
- · CONNECT THE REAR SEAT WIRE TO THE HOVERBOARD'S CHARGING PORT.
- POWER ON THE HOVERBOARD THE LIGHTS WILL TURN ON ONCE THE HOVERBOARD AND THE SEAT WIRE ARE PLUGGED IN.
- THE DEFAULT LIGHTING MODE WILL DISPLAY WHEN THE REMIX AND HOVERBOARD ARE BOTH CONNECTED AND POWERED ON.
- SHORT PRESS THE POWER BUTTON TO SWITCH BETWEEN DIFFERENT LIGHTING EFFECTS.

PLEASE NOTE: THE CONNECTOR SHOULD ALWAYS BE CONNECTED WHILE RIDING.

2. Make Moves

2.1 Getting on the Remix

- PLACE THE REMIX ON A FLAT SURFACE WITH THE HOVERBOARD TURNED OFF.
- CAREFULLY SIT IN REMIX PLACING YOUR FEET ON THE FOOTREST.
- MAKE SURE THE HOVERBOARD IS LEVELED.
- TURN ON HOVERBOARD.

NOTE: DO NOT TURN ON THE HOVERBOARD BEFORE YOU SIT DOWN. IF THE HOVERBOARD IS NOT LEVELED WHEN YOU TURN IT ON, THE REMIX WILL GO FORWARD OR BACKWARD IMMEDIATELY.



2.2 Helmet Safety





PROPER POSITIONING: THE FOREHEAD IS COVERED BY THE HELMET. IMPROPER POSITIONING: THE FOREHEAD IS EXPOSED. COULD CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.

* WEAR A HELMET, APPROPRIATE CLOTHING, SHOES, AND SAFETY GEAR. AVOID CLOTHING THAT CAN GET CAUGHT INTO OR UNDER THE WHEELS. CLOSED-TOE, FLAT SHOES ARE RECOMMENDED. WEAR AN ASTM F1492 APPROVED HELMET AND PROTECTIVE GEAR TO PREVENT INJURY IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT.

2.3 Riding the Remix.

NOTE: TIGHTEN ALL SCREWS AND LOCKING NUTS BEFORE EACH RIDE.






TO GO FORWARD - PUSH DOWN BOTH HANDLES



TO TURN RIGHT – PUSH DOWN LEFT HANDLE, PULL UP RIGHT HANDLE TO BRAKE / REVERSE - PULL UP BOTH HANDLES



TO TURN LEFT – PULL UP LEFT HANDLE, PUSH DOWN RIGHT HANDLE



NOTE: DON'T PULL UP OR DOWN ON THE HANDLES TOO HARD AS IT MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO LOCK. THE HANDLES WILL LOCK IN PLACE WHEN PULLED 22° UP AND 22° DOWN BASED ON NETURAL POSITION OF BRACKETS.

2.4 Riding the Hoverboard







Care & Maintenance

RIDING RANGE

THE MAXIMUM RANGE IS 12 MILES. HOWEVER, MANY FACTORS WILL AFFECT HOW FAR YOU CAN GO PER CHARGE:

- DRIVING SURFACE: A SMOOTH, FLAT SURFACE WILL INCREASE DRIVING DISTANCE.
- WEIGHT: MORE WEIGHT MEANS LESS DISTANCE.
- TEMPERATURE: RIDE, STORE, AND CHARGE THE REMIX ABOVE 50°F.
- MAINTENANCE: TIMELY BATTERY CHARGING OF UP TO 4 HOURS PER CHARGE WILL INCREASE DRIVING DISTANCE.
- DRIVING STYLE: FREQUENT STARTING AND STOPPING WILL REDUCE DRIVING DISTANCE.

CLEANING THE REMIX

• TO CLEAN THE REMIX, CAREFULLY WIPE WITH A DAMP CLOTH, THEN DRY WITH A DRY CLOTH.

• DO NOT USE WATER TO CLEAN THE REMIX, AS THE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS MAY GET WET, RESULTING IN PERSONAL INJURY OR MALFUNCTION OF THE REMIX.

• IF THE ELECTRIC PARTS OR BATTERY GET WET, DO NOT POWER ON THE REMIX. PLEASE CONTACT JETSON CUSTOMER CARE FOR ASSISTANCE.

BATTERY

- KEEP AWAY FROM FIRE AND EXCESSIVE HEAT.
- AVOID INTENSE PHYSICAL SHOCK, SEVERE VIBRATION, OR IMPACT.
- PROTECT FROM WATER OR MOISTURE.
