

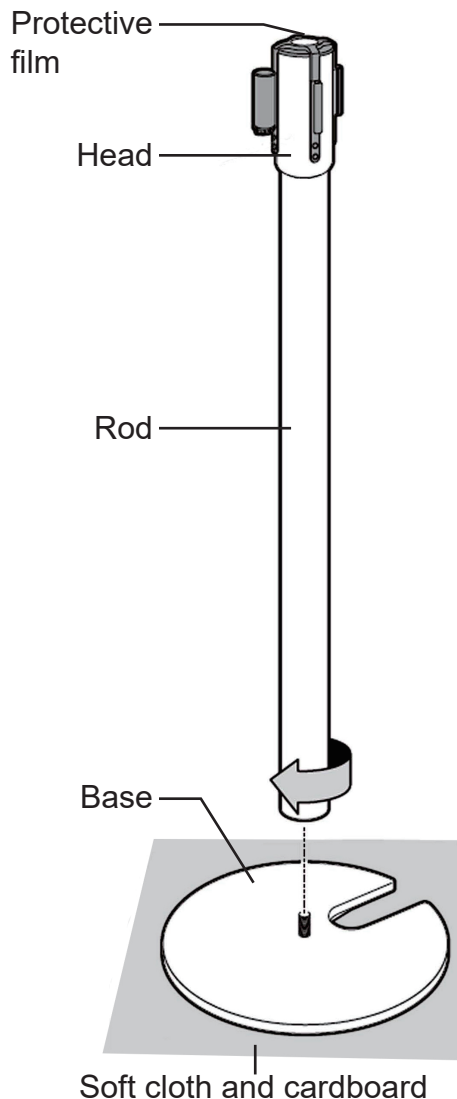
USER MANUAL

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety and the safety of others are very important to us. Please read all instructions before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product.

- Do not use this product for other purposes. It may cause an accident or injury.
- Install this product in a level place. If used in unlevel places, this product may fall down and be broken or cause injury.
- Do not use on stairs. This product may tip over or be broken.
- Please pull the belt along the horizontal direction. The belt may be twisted or broken if pulled at an angle.
- Do not over-pull the belt. This may result in falls, damage, or injury.
- Do not loosen your hand suddenly when pulling out the belt. A collision at the front of the belt may cause injury or damage.

- Do not set this product near the fire. It may cause fire or damage.
- Tighten the head, the rod, and the base of this product before use. If they are loose, they may cause injury or damage.
- Do not use it when an exception is found.
- Do not use it in water.
- Do not fall or collide.
- Do not use it in direct sunlight, hot places, or near heating equipment. It may cause deformation, discoloration, or damage.
- Do not lean or ride this product.
- Do not put items on this product.
- Be careful during assembly, as parts may fall off.
- Do not pile this product in unstable conditions.
- Do not use this product when it is stacking. It may cause a drop or damage.
- Do not brandish this product.



GETTING STARTED

Precautions For Assembly

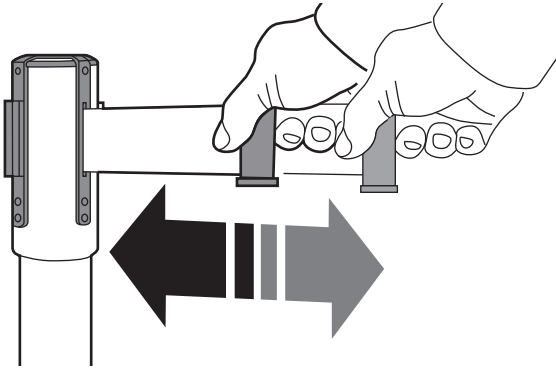
- Be careful not to clip your fingers.
- Line the floor with a soft cloth or cardboard box when assembling.
- Firmly tighten the joint of the head, the rod, and the base to the end.
- Do not exert excessive force on the product from the side.

Assembly Instruction

Align the rod with the bolt in the center of the base. Slowly turn the rod until it is tight.

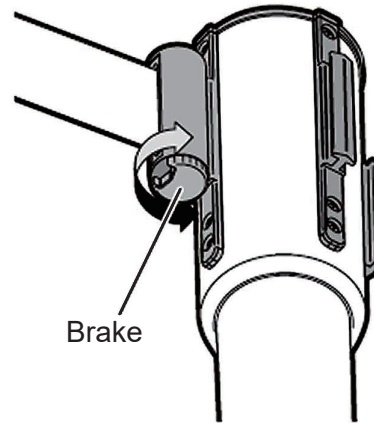
Before Use

- Make sure the head, the rod, and the base are tightened to avoid injury and damage.
- Remove the protective film at the top of the head before use.
- The belt should be pulled out slowly in the horizontal direction.
- When pulling the belt for retrieve, slowly put it back in place along the horizontal direction. If you pull it in an oblique direction, it may not twist back.



Anti-trip Brake

After connecting the belt, turn the brake to prevent the belt from falling off.



MAINTENANCE

- Wipe with a soft cloth.
- If the stain is stubborn, remove the stain with diluted neutral detergent (1%-3%). To avoid detergent residue, wipe it with water with a wrung out cloth, then wipe it with a soft cloth.
