

220L Compost Tumbler

Tumbleweed's 220L Compost Tumbler is ideal for small gardens and courtyards - you can even place it on concrete or pavers. You'll find Tumbleweed's 220L Compost Tumbler is the easiest way to compost - just load the barrel then turn it every few days. A built in breaker bar will mix and aerate to speed decomposition, leaving you with fantastic mulch in just four weeks or rich compost in six.

Instructions for use

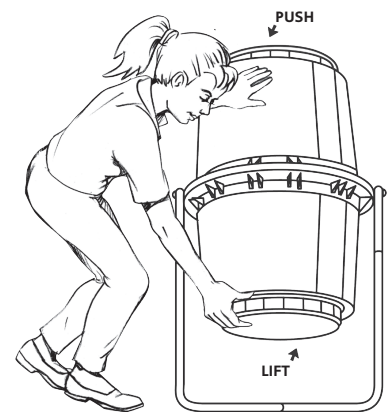
You don't need to generate a large amount of organic waste to begin making compost.

However, whether you choose to layer the tumbler in one go or add to it slowly, you'll need to tumble it several times every two days. This will aerate the compost and encourage the micro-organisms to work efficiently.

Over time, the contents of your 220L Compost Tumbler will reduce as it decomposes so that a full tumbler of organic waste will reduce to about 25% of its volume as compost.

Tumbling your Compost Tumbler is easy. Simply stand at its side and place one hand at each end of the tumbler. Tumble by pushing down on one hand and lifting it with the other, as shown in the diagram.

Your compost will be ready in approximately four to six weeks from the time you last 'fed' it.



A few final recommendations

- Refer to the list of compostable materials and follow the instructions it provides
- Try to maintain a balance between "green" and "brown" waste"
- Ensure that the compost is moist without being wet
- Never fill the Tumbler over halfway. This is important to maintain a manageable weight to ensure you can turn the Tumbler every two days.
