





Racing is underway for 2022!

Jazz (Farr 40, Mark Itnyre) opened the year for NYCLB boats in the Long Beach YC Two Gates Pursuit Race on January 9. Jazz finished 12th overall and 6th in her class.

Seal Beach YC began their Saturday Sailors series on January 22. Jazz took 4th place in PHRF AA. Shadowfax (J-109, Chris Mewes) was 3rd in PHRF A2 and Dawn Patrol (Catalina 30, Paul Turang) won PHRF D. This series continues on February 5, February 26, March 12 and March 26. On February 19 & 20, the 92nd annual SCYA Midwinter Regatta will be back after a COVID hiatus in 2021. PHRF classes for the Long Beach area will be hosted by Seal Beach YC.

For 2022 we're also establishing criteria for the NYCLB Top Gun race competition. This award will be presented at the Annual Membership Meeting to recognize participation and success in sailboat racing by NYCLB skippers.

The following criteria will be used to determine the NYCLB Top Gun winner:

Eligible Boats: Any boat owned by a NYCLB member and registered for a qualifying event under the NYCLB burgee.

Qualifying Events: Any event on the Association of San Pedro Bay Yacht Clubs racing calendar (http://www.aspbyc.org/p/race-calendar_21.html) which is open to PHRF classes. The Top Gun competition will conclude each year with the Navy Day Regatta in October (events after the Navy Day Regatta will count toward the following year's score).

Scoring:

One point for participating in any qualifying event (including DNS, DNF, NSC, DSQ or RET – does not include DNC)

Bonus of 0.5 points for participating in a Long Beach High Points Series (LBHPS) event hosted by Little Ships Fleet, Shoreline or Seal Beach Yacht Clubs

Bonus of 1 point for participating in NYCLB hosted regattas (including NYCLB-hosted LBHPS events)

Bonus of 0.5 points for class win in any qualifying event

Bonus of 3 points for winner of Navy Day Trophy

The Race Committee will monitor results for qualifying events and maintain running scores, which will be posted in each month's Scuttlebutt newsletter. A boat may obtain details about her current score by contacting the Race Chair via email and may correct her results by providing documentation of participation in qualifying events.

Tuesday Salty Sailors




Want to race? We have your ride!




