## Fleet Captain Peter Axelrod






To recap our December, 2021 events:

NYCLB is looking forward to another full season of race activities for 2022. Our racing schedule includes:

Ongoing Tuesday afternoon Salty Sailors series, every Tuesday (weather permitting...)

Armed Forces Day Regatta, scheduled for Saturday, May 7

All Hands Regatta, scheduled for Saturday, September 10

Navy Day Regatta, scheduled for Saturday, October 15

Participation in the Long Beach Harbor High Points Series in conjunction with Shoreline YC, Seal Beach YC and Little Ships Fleet

We're also hoping to put a team together to compete again for the Walt Elliott Harbor Challenge trophy. Long Beach Yacht Club will be defending and the regatta is scheduled for May 15. More to come as the challenge and our plans firm up.

A word about safety at sea. U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Regulations require that for races rated as Coastal (like Newport to Ensenada) or Ocean (like Transpac) at least 30% of the crew must have attended a U.S. Sailing Safety at Sea Seminar within the previous 5 years. These seminars are also a good idea for any sailor, whether you're just putting around the harbor, heading over to Catalina for a weekend or doing some coastal cruising. Topics include giving assistance, personal safety gear, crew overboard rescue, emergency communications and search & rescue.

U.S. Sailing offers an online course (\$45 for U.S. Sailing members, \$50 for non-members) and the seminars are offered live at various venues (prices vary based on course content and venue). Over the next few months in-person seminars are scheduled locally at Del Rey YC, San Diego YC & Bahia Corinthian YC.

## Tuesday Salty Sailors




### **Want to race? We have your ride!**






