Race Chair Report for December 2018

The last race of 2018 has been raced. We are all looking forward to the first race of 2019. Since the first day of 2019 is a Tuesday, let's get started with a Salty Sailor Tuesday race on New Years Day!

A change for the sailing racers in 2019 will be a reformatting of what was the Long Beach Harbor Series. For 2019 this will become the Long Beach Harbor High Point Series. Each participating club will sponsor and manage their own races. But additionally, for races identified in the Long Beach Harbor High Point Series there will be separate scoring and trophies to be presented at NYCLB after the last series race in September 2019. Tuesday's Salty Sailors sailing continues. The races are a pursuit style race and goal is to finish close together. If you don't have a sailing vessel just bring yourself – there is always a skipper in need of crew. Meet at the the club any Tuesday at 11:30. The club website has the most recent NYCLB Senior Salty Sailors course chart: dated **2 November 2018**.

The Tuesday SS results follow:

Tuesday 27 Nov: On the last Tuesday in November we had five boats on course 54. this was a 7.1 mile race with a reach to mark 39 followed by a beat up to 36, then a downwind run to 38s and the finish at the A buoy in the harbor entrance. The wind ranged between 4.5 with a top range of 8.5 to 9.0 knots. It was a fun afternoon competitive race with Raptor in first place by a nose, Nui Koa, Fait Lux, Shadowfax and Green Dragon.

Tuesday 4 Dec: We had three boats on course 1, a 3.7 mile race with a beat to mark 31 followed by a tight reach to 34 and a beat back to 38. The wind ranged between 2.5 with a top range of 7.0 knots. It was another great afternoon sail with Green Dragon in first place followed by Fait Lux and Shadowfax.

Tuesday 11 Dec : On this Tuesday we had three boats on course 8, a 3.1 mile race. The wind ranged between 4.0 with a top range of 7.0 knots. It was a fun afternoon

sail with Green Dragon in first place (again) followed by Dos Amigos and Fait Lux.

Tuesday 18 Dec: Four boats raced on course 56, a 6.3 mile race in the big swells. The wind ranged between 6.0 with a top range of 11.0 knots. It was a fun afternoon sail with Fait Lux leading the fleet from start to finish, followed by Love & War, Dos Amigos and at the back of the pack Shadowfax.

Tuesday's Salty Sailors will skip Tuesday 25 December but will start in 2019 with the first race on Tuesday, 1 January (yes, New Years day!)




