#### **Race Chair Report for November 2019**

Navy YC Long Beach racers are coming to the end of another great year of racing in Southern California. The last race series of 2019 will be over on 1 December. With one race to go in the Sunday Sailors Series, our racers are in the hunt for trophies again. In PHRF A, Raptor is in first and Shadowbox is just one point out of second. In PHRF C Dawn Patrol is in Second and Renegade is in 5th but just 3 points from 3rd. Good luck to everyone in the final race. Then it's time to get our boats ready for next year - racing starts again the first week in January - only in Southern California!!

**Tuesday's Salty Sailors** sailing continues - we will sail year-round. If you don't have a sailing vessel just bring yourself, bring you friends and family — there is always a skipper in need of crew. We meet at the the club any Tuesday at 11:30. The club website has the most recent NYCLB Senior Salty Sailors course chart. Gather up your friends and family and join us.

The Tuesday SS results follow:

**Tuesday 22 October:** We had seven boats on course # 20, a 7.8-mile cruise of the harbor. The wind ranged from 5.0 to 16.5 knots.

Our first leg was a beat out to the west end of the breakwater taking Mark 36 to starboard, the next leg was a run to Mark 27, the Long Beach center channel R2 Buoy, from there we head off on a downwind run towards the Belmont Pier, rounding Mark 34, to starboard. Our next leg paralleled the beach on our way to Mark 32, from there we headed out on a beat to the east side of Island Chaffee rounding Mark 38 to port and off on reach to the finish at the Alamitos Bay A Buoy.

In first place Lucky Boy, followed closely by Shadowfax, Swell Lover, Windhaven, Love and War, Macs and new to the fleet Stainte.

**Tuesday 29 October:** On this Tuesday we had six boats on course # 50, a 8.4 mile cruise of the harbor chop. The wind ranged from 6.0 to 14.0 knots.

Our first leg was a beat/slog through the wind chop out to the Anaheim Bay Chanel Buoy R "2" from there we headed off on a reach to the center of the beach rounding Mark 33. The next leg out to Mark 31 proved challenging for some of us with an 80 degree wind shifts on the east side of the course, unfortunately Shadowfax and Windhaven were on the east side while Raptor was on the favored side of the shift beating us out to the wall by seven minutes (ouch). From there we head back towards the beach rounding Mark 34 at the Belmont Pier and the off to the finish at Mark 38.

In first place, with a horizon job on the fleet, Raptor followed hours later by Shadowfax, Windhaven, SLainte, Luck Boy and Macs -DNF

**Tuesday 12 November:** We had six boats on course # 53, a 5.9-mile zigzag cruise of the harbor. The wind ranged from 6.0 to 13.0 knots.

Our first leg was a beat out to the center of the breakwater rounding Mark 37 to starboard, from there we headed west on a tight reach to the Long Beach Center Channel R "2" buoy rounding it to starboard. On the next leg, we headed east paralleling the beach on our way to the west end of the Alamitos Bay jetty, rounding Mark 32 to starboard. The final leg was a beat to the finish at Mark 38.

In first place, Callisto followed by Windhaven, Swell Lover, Shadowfax, Raptor and Luck Boy - DNF

**Tuesday 19 November:** We had six boats on course # 37, a 6.1-mile cruise of the harbor. The wind ranged from 5.5 to 10.0 knots.

Our first leg was a beat out to the East end of the breakwater rounding Mark 31 to starboard, from there we headed on an enjoyable reach splitting two anchored freighters on our way to the Long Beach Center Channel R "2" buoy - Mark 27 rounding it to starboard. As we headed off towards Island Grissom on a wing-on-wing run, the wind decrease and a work barge decided to cut through the fleet on our approach to Mark 39. The last leg to the finish was a 2.5-mile tight reach to Mark 38.

In first place, by miles, Macs followed by Shadowfax, Callisto II, SLainte, Luck Boy and Raptor- DNF.
