So much has happened since January 1 with lots of good news to report!

First, planning for our 2019 Opening Day on April 6 is going smoothly. As always, we have many volunteers to help with the festivities. I would like all those interested in volunteering to attend a planning meeting at **11:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 9** at the clubhouse. If you cannot attend, and if you have not already stepped up to volunteer, please send me an email to let me know you're interested. Also, if there's a particular task or area where you'd like to volunteer, let me know.

As some of you may remember, last year I talked to everyone about parking passes for all members. It's finally happening! If you do not have a boat in Alamitos Bay or Shoreline (and thus you already have a parking pass), you will receive a parking pass. Parking passes will be distributed by Rear Commodore Rodney Coomber as soon as we receive them. Stay tuned!

Now for fee-free dock access for NYCLB members! The requested dates have been revised and the Marina is now rescheduling the city council presentation for approval in February—just in time for our 2019 boating season!

Our Lease draft is at its final approval stage at the city. Terms include:

- 15 years \$900.00 per month (that's only a \$27.00 per month increase), with the stipulation that NYCLB will improve the property over the 15-year term.
- The draft will include a Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) expenditure for NYCLB with funding that has been allocated for over 10 years.

Once we receive the first lease draft the Board of Directors will need to approve.

Heinz Butner Race Chair Report for January 2019

While our counterparts on the east coast are still frozen in, racing has started here in Long Beach for the 2019 season! There are four Navy YC boats sailing in the Seal Beach Saturday Sailors Series, Dawn Patrol (Paul Turang), Renegade (Ben Smith), Shadowfax (Chris Mewes) and Raptor (Heinz Butner).

Next up will be the reformatted Long Beach Harbor Series. For 2019 this will become the Long Beach Harbor High Point Series. Each participating club will sponsor and manage their own races. But additionally, for these races there will be separate scoring and trophies to be presented at NYCLB after the last series race in September 2019. The following races have been agreed to by the participating clubs:

Tuesday's Salty Sailors sailing continues. If you don't have a sailing vessel just bring yourself, bring you friends and family – there is always a skipper in need of crew. We meet at the the club any Tuesday at 11:30. The club website has the most recent NYCLB Senior Salty Sailors course chart: dated **2 November 2018**.

The Tuesday SS results follow:

Tuesday 1 Jan: The two red flags on the lifeguard station flag poll indicating Gale Warnings scuttled our plan to race on New Year's Day. Hideki Tsuda (the most famous Facebook chronicler) had invited several "out of school" kids along. Not to disappoint the group, Green Dragon rigged the first and second mainsail reef and took the group out for an afternoon sail. Of course, the act of rigging the reef caused the wind to die so it ended up being a nice easy afternoon sail.



Tuesday 8 Jan: We had five boats on course 44, a 5.0-mile race. We started with a tight reach out to Anaheim Chanel Buoy #3, followed with a reach back to the beach mark 33, finishing with a beat up to mark 38. The wind ranged between 4.0 with a top range of 9.0 knots. It was a fun afternoon sail with Green Dragon in first, followed by Dos Amigos, Shadowfax, Swell Lover and Raptor. Raptor finished the race with a bicycle innertube wrapped on some underwater appendage. The innertube tube was recovered and donated as a trophy for the best excuse for not winning a race.

Tuesday 15 Jan: On this rainy day we had three boats (Raptor, Callisto and Shadowfax) but no crew because of the rain...

Tuesday 22 Jan: Last Tuesday we had five boats on course 10, a 7.2-mile race, with two windward/leeward legs (37 to 32). The wind ranged between 6.5 and topped out at about 12.0 knots. It was a fun afternoon sail with Green Dragon in first (again), followed by Raptor, Shadowfax, the new Macs (B25) and Swell Lover.
