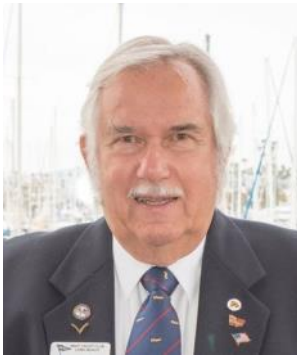

Race Chair Report for March 2019

The last race of the five race Saturday Sailors Series was on March 9th. Four Navy YC boats participated in the Seal Beach YC sponsored Series; Dawn Patrol (Paul Turang), Renegade (Ben Smith), Shadowfax (Chris Mewes) and Raptor (Heinz Butner). In the PHRF B fleet, Raptor took 1st place with four firsts (one through-out series). Shadowfax was close behind in 3rd. In the PHRF C fleet Dawn Patrol finished in 3rd place. Next up will be the first race of the Long Beach Harbor Series; the April Fools Race out of Shoreline YC on 30 March.

Tuesday's Salty Sailors sailing continues. If you don't have a sailing vessel just bring yourself, bring you friends and family – there is always a skipper in need of crew. We meet at the the club any Tuesday at 11:30. The club website has the most recent NYCLB Senior Salty Sailors course chart: dated **2 November 2018**.

We have recently had to leave boats at the dock because we didn't have enough crew to adequately crew all the boats available. So gather up your friends and family and join us. It is spring already so get out on the water!

The Tuesday SS results follow:

Tuesday 26 Feb: On this Tuesday, we had six boats on course 58, a distance of 6.7 miles. The wind ranged from 6.0 to 11.0 knots, mostly in 8.0 knot range. We started the sail with a beat up to mark 31 on the breakwater wall, followed by a nice reach to the R2 Buoy (mark 27). The next leg was a downwind run to mark 39, just east of Island Grissom. We finished with a 2.5mile run along the beach to the Alamos Bay entrance A Buoy.

In first place Windhaven, followed by Fait Lux, Raptor and Love & War, Green Dragon and Shadowfax were OCS and disqualified.

Tuesday 12 March : We had four boats on course 57 a distance of 7.3 miles. The wind ranged from 3.0 to 18.0 knots, mostly in 12.0 knot range. Since mark 38 is still “missing”, used the last boats to start as a virtual mark 38. Just as those boats started the wind dropped from 12 knots to about 3. And as they reached Mark 35 near the Seal Beach pier, the wind picked up again and shifted around so the “reach” to mark 27 became a beat to weather. The race finished at the Alamitos Bay entrance A Buoy with three of the boats in close proximity. In first place Green Dragon, followed by Macs’ (the new B25), Raptor and Swell Lover.

Tuesday 19 March: We had five boats on course 34 R (Reverse), a distance of 7.3 miles. The wind ranged from 7.0 to 12.0 knots, mostly in 8 knot range. Mark 38 is still “missing”, so we used a line sight from the end of the break wall (Mark 10) to the tower on Island Chaffee. The near windward/leeward course went from Mark 38 (imaginary) to Mark 31 at the break wall to Mark 34 near Belmont pier, back to Mark 31 and 34 a second time and finished at the Alamitos Bay Harbor entrance A buoy. Shifting winds, in strength and direction made it a challenging course. On the final beat from Mark 34 to the entrance buoy, with the wind coming from 180 degrees, it looked like we could make it on one tack. That illusion was short lived when the wind first died behind Island Chaffee, shifted to 160 degrees and finally headed us at 125 degrees! Everyone had to tack on that - by the time we got to the entrance it was bowing 15+ knots. In first place was Raptor, followed by Shadowfax. Windhaven, Green Dragon, and Macs’ (the new B25) were far enough back of the leaders that this author did not record their order of finish. Our handicapping seems to result in the boats being closer together at the finish on Random Leg courses than it is on Windward/Leeward courses.

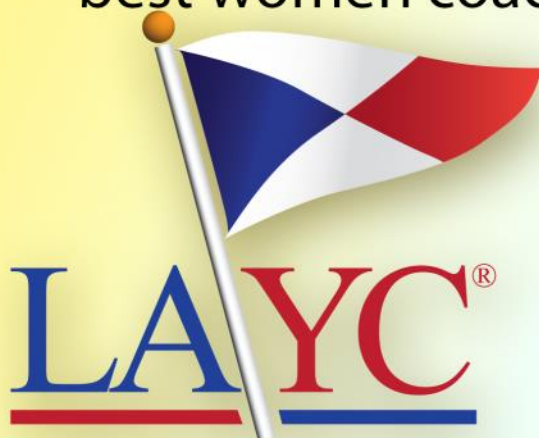

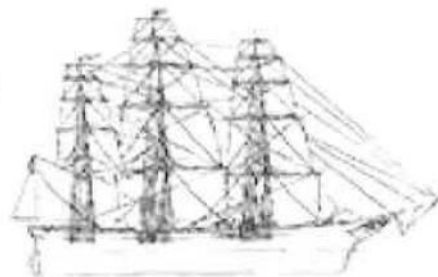
