The fifth race of the Long Beach Harbor Series, the "Beat the Heat Race" was conducted by Little Ships Fleet YC on Saturday 13 July 2019. This turned out to be a very lightly attended Race. There were two spinnaker class boats and 3 non-spin boats racing. In the spin class, Raptor won the race when Dos Amigos dropped out while sailing the weather leg outside the outer breakwall. In the non Spin class, it was Fiat Lux (1st), Que Linda (2nd) and Bellissima (3rd). With the completion of five of eight races, Fiat Lux is the overall leader in the series.

NYCLB boats are representing the club in races around the harbor. Shadowfax, Renegade and Dawn Patrol are racing in the SIBYC Thursday night Pop-Tops. In series three after three races, Shadowfax is 1st in PHRF B, and Dawn Patrol is tied for 2nd in PHRF D. Raptor competed in the Second series of the Long Beach YC Wet Wednesday's and was 1st PHRF fleet.

Tuesday's Salty Sailors sailing continues. If you don't have a sailing vessel just bring yourself, bring you friends and family – there is always a skipper in need of crew. We meet at the the club any Tuesday at 11:30. The club website has the most recent NYCLB Senior Salty Sailors course chart: **Check for the most recent chart just out for July racing!!**

Gather up your friends and family and join us.

The Tuesday SS results follow:

Tuesday 2 July: On this Tuesday we had five boats on course #5, a six mile course starting off with an east to west cruise along the Long Beach Breakwater, Mark 31 followed by Mark 37, Mark 30 and Mark 36, all taken to starboard. On our next leg we were on a run to Mark 27 - Buoy R2, we then headed off on a tight reached between the oil platforms to Mark 38, finishing at the A - Buoy.

The wind ranged between 5.0 to just barely 8.0 knots.

In first place, Raptor followed by Shadowfax, Windhaven, Sorrento Siren and Lucky Boy.

Tuesday 9 July: We had six boats on course #57, a 7.3 mile tour of the harbor:

On the first leg we headed south on a reach to Mark 35 - Seal Beach Pier, from there we headed across the bay on a (3.5 mile) tight reach to Mark 27 - R2 buoy in the middle of the Long Beach Harbor Main Channel. Our next leg was along the Long Beach Breakwater to Mark 31 - east end of the breakwater. Our final leg was a deep run to the A Buoy. Overall a fun, but challenging course.

The wind started off in the 8 knot range and built to 16.0

In first place, Raptor followed by Shadowfax, Swell Lover, Windhaven, Dad's Dream and Sorrento Siren.

Tuesday 16 July: On this Tuesday we had four boats and lots of crew on course #60, a 7.7 mile tour of the harbor:

On the first leg we headed up to Mark 31 on the east end of breakwater, from there we headed on a tight reach to Mark 35 - West end of the Seal Beach Pier. Our next leg (3.5 miles) took us across the bay on reach to Mark 39 - West end of Island Grissom. Our final leg was a tight reach back to Mark - 38 for the finish.

The wind stayed in an enjoyable range of 6 knot to 10 knots.

In first place, Shadowfax followed by Swell Lover, Green Dragon and Windhaven.

In an effort to make it fun for all participants, next week we plan on allowing Dad's Dream and Sorrento Siren additional time. For those of you who have not sailed your boats with us for while we will make appropriate rating adjustments (Callisto II, Amelieden, Buenafe, etc.)

Tuesday 23 July: We had 6 boats that started on course #7. This was a 7.2 mile course from Mark 38 to Mark 31 on the other breakaway then to Mark 36 near Queens Gate. The course then continued to Mark 39 near Shoreline marina and back to Mark 32 near the Alamitos bay Entrance and then finished at the "A" bouy in the entrance.

Four boats finished the course in in a little over an hour. First boat to finish was Shadowfax, followed by Raptor, Green Dragon and Windhaven.
