2018 "Solid + Sensible" Field Blend



Grape(s): 25% Syrah, 25% Roussanne, 20% Zinfandel, 20% Marsanne, 10% Viognier

Vineyard(s): Poor Ranch: Sitting at 1,200 feet elevation, Poor Ranch boasts over 200 acres of CCOF certified, dry-farmed varieties, all done in the family's characteristic hands-off approach -- no irrigation, chemicals, sprinklers, nor fans for first protection.

Bonofiglio: Bonofiglio is a seven acre plot planted on what used to be the Russian River in the town of Hopland, lending its name to the soils known as Russian River loam. This vineyard is CCOF certified organic, and hopes to become Demeter-certified Biodynamic.

AVA: Mendocino County

Method: This cuvée is a mashup of three separate lots. The first is a co-ferment of whole-cluster Syrah, Marsanne and Viognier (both destemmed) that was left on the skins for 3 weeks. The second is a blend of Syrah and Zin - the Syrah went carbonic for a month and the whole clusters of Zin were left on the skins for 2 ½ weeks. The third is a blend of Viognier, Marsanne, and Roussanne - the Viognier went carbonic for 2 weeks before being pressed together with the Marsanne and Roussanne. After 7 months in neutral barrels, the wine was blended, racked into a stainless tank for 2 months before bottling unfined, unfiltered, and with no SO2.
