

Sure-Fit Designs Photo Guide for Fitting Advice Pants Fitting

Sure-Fit Designs prides itself on its excellent customer service and after-sales support.

To give the best fitting advice we ask for photos of customers in their first pants toile. These photos need to be of good quality and in a format that it makes it easier for us and you to analyse.

This guide describes what we need.

- ✂ **In all photos please keep arms and body straight; do not twist to take a photo.**
- ✂ **The camera or device taking the photo should not obscure the picture.**
- ✂ **Photos should be taken at Pants level where possible, not from a higher position looking down.**
- ✂ **The first fitting is often done with an elastic at the waist...but keep in mind that tucking the fabric under the elastic can distort the appearance and hang of the pants. A 1" waistband can be tacked on if preferred.**



Opening/Zipper Space

The opening can be front or side, but the 5/8" stitching lines identifying the seam, must be carefully aligned and pinned.

Alternatively a zip can be inserted.



Front & Back Views

Please provide a photo of both the front and back looking straight at the pants.

Hem allowance should be pinned or pressed in place so that the fabric does not hang up on your foot

Any top needs to be out of the way.



Side Views

We need to see both a left and right side view to enable us to see if the seam line is running straight.

Using two colours of fabric works well.
