## Directions For Use:

01 Ensure surface is clean, dry and free from contaminants.

02 Preferably use a foam or microfibre applicator for even coverage, and apply a thin amount using light pressure in back and forward motions, covering a panel at a time. Use sparingly and do not over apply.

03 Once cured (approx. 5 - 10 minutes) remove excess dried residue with a soft microfibre towel or cloth.

04 For best results and protection top with a paste wax or sealant.

**NOTE:** Do not apply to the vehicle in extremes of temperature, below 6 degrees Celsius, or above 35 degrees Celsius or in direct sunlight.

**STORAGE:** Store the bottle in an upright position in a cool dark place and ensure lid is replaced after use.

**HAND APPLICATION:** For best results use a microfibre or foam applicator pad. Apply a small-coin sized drop of product to the applicator and work into the paint with light pressure in circular, or linear motions until the residue turns clear. For best results work on a small area at a time. Once the product has been fully worked in, remove the residue and buff using a clean, soft microfibre cloth or towel.

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## Directions For Use:

**Dual Action (DA) Polisher:** For application by Dual Action (DA) polisher, the use of a light foam finishing or polishing pad is recommended. Apply 2-3 small-coin sized drops to the pad, and spread onto a small area of the paint using the lowest setting on the machine, followed by slow, overlapping passes, light pressure and a moderate speed setting (4000 OPMs) until the residue starts to turn clear. At this stage, back the speed down to its lowest setting, or second lowest setting and reduce pressure for one more pass. Leave the residue to haze for a few minutes and

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buff off using a clean, soft microfibre cloth or towel. For maximum gloss and shine, a foam finishing pad is ideal. For maximum polishing performance, or on harder paint types, a slightly firmer foam polishing pad is recommended.

**Rotary Polisher:** For application by Rotary Polisher, the use of a light foam finishing or polishing pad is recommended. Apply 2-3 small-coin sized drops to the pad and spread onto a small area of the paint using the lowest speed setting on the machine. At this stage increase the speed to a

maximum of 1000RPM, working the product into the surface using slow, overlapping passes. Once the residue starts to turn clear, reduce the speed down to its lowest setting for one more pass. Leave the residue to haze for a few minutes and buff off using a clean, soft microfibre cloth or towel. For maximum gloss and shine, a foam finishing pad is ideal. For maximum polishing performance, or on harder paint types, a slightly firmer foam polishing pad is recommended. Stage, back the speed down to its lowest setting, or second lowest setting and reduce pressure for one more
