Speaker Boxes for Home Audio/Theaters

- Noisy garage doors

- Any other resonant and/or rattling surface!

Prepping the Surface

Start by getting all surfaces clean from dust, debris, oil, wax and moisture. with a microfiber cloth and Acetone or an alcohol based cleaner.

Installation

Mock the material up on the surface you plan to install it on to measure the material size you will need. If the material needs to be cut, use a blade, exacto knife, or scissors.

Then, peel off the backing paper and use a roller to apply the material, working your way from one side to the other (from top to bottom is recommended) to minimize any trapped air pockets.

If you see any trapped air, you can use the point of a razor blade or needle to poke a hole and push down on the material. It is important to ensure the material has proper contact to the surface for lasting adhesion.
