**Alcohol based cleaner  
& microfiber towel**



**Gloves**



**Sharp blade or

### Prepping the Surface

Start by getting all metal surfaces clean from dust, oil, wax and moisture. We recommend using a microfiber cloth and an alcohol based cleaning solution such as denatured alcohol or Invisible Glass. If you have rust, it may require a bit more attention to ensure the material will stick well. Once all the surfaces have been prepped and air dried, you can start applying the material.

### Installation

Roll the material out on a flat surface and measure the size you will need. Paper or cardboard can be used to cut templates. Cut the material to your desired size using a sharp blade or scissors. It is best to apply the material from the top down using a roller so you can work the material all one direction and minimize any trapped air pockets.

If you see any trapped air, you can use the point of a razor blade or a sewing needle to poke a hole and push down on the material. Ensure the adhesive has proper contact to the metal surface to adhere properly, and check that any holes that require fastening hardware are not blocked.
