

## PARASITE INFORMATION FACT SHEET

The paramount function of the gastrointestinal system is to break down food into nutrients to be used up by our body to grow and heal. Usually misdiagnosed or underdiagnosed are parasites are troublesome to the healthy gut and illicit signs such as constipation, diarrhoea, bloating, flatulence, low grade fever weight loss, rectal itching, chronic fatigue or could be asymptomatic. Here at The Compounding Pharmacy Australia we compound products to eliminate infections including: *E.coli, Blastocystis Hominis, D. Fragilis, Giardia, Entamoeba Histolytica, Enterococus Faecalis.* 

As parasites are stubborn to eradicate, we have carefully formulated antibiotics in capsule form(some ENTERIC COATED) promoting compliance. Treatment may include using one or more of the following antibiotics listed below. They should be taken **in combination** as seen below at the **same time every day with food**.

To ensure successful treatment, patient must complete the entire medication schedule as directed. Alcohol should be avoided. Some side effects patients may experience include:

Nausea and vomiting

Thrush

Headaches

Allergy

Itching

tiredness

Note: If the patient is taking Oral contraceptive pill, these antibiotics may decrease the Pill's efficacy and hence should use other forms of contraception.

Due to parasitic resistance, patient should be retested via stool analysis 4-6 weeks after treatment.

To replenish and balance the gut flora after antibiotic treatment, we carry Practitioner lines which are beneficial where you may include in your practice and includes:

- Saccharomyces cerevisiae (Boulardii) 250mg (Bioceuticals, Medlab), 500mg (Spectrumceuticals)
- **Fridge probiotics** (Bioceuticals, Spectrumceuticals, Nutritioncare, Metagenics), Bioceuticals **Intestamine** to repair gut lining wall, **Bone broth**
- Mutaflor (containing E.Coli)
