

At-Home Tape Removal Method

Section —
Separate out your lowest row at the nape of your neck, and clip the rest of your hair on top like a bun, hold in place with the sectioning clips
Spray —
Using the Removal Solution, liberally spray the top of your tape extensions where they connect to your natural hair
Seperate —
Take the 'tail' end of the tail comb and starting from the middle (left to right) of the tape extensions, gently seperates the two sides (top and bottom)
Use the Removal Solution if required. Do not pull the extensions apart forcefully as this may result in damage to your natural hair or your extensions
Remove —
Once separated from the natural hair, put the extension sandwich back together, and set aside each row keeping them all together. (Your extensions at the top and sides will be slightly shorter if layered than your extensions at the back. If you would like your extensions to be placed back in, to assist with replacement – keep each row together with a loose elastic band, or zip lock bag and make a note of what section this row has come from)
Shampoo —
Take a little of the Clarifying Shampoo and massage into the section of hair you have just removed your tape extensions from. Comb through entire section of hair starting from the ends and slowly working your way to the top to loosen any natural shedding or residure that is left in your natural hair. PLEASE NOTE - It's normal to shed between 50-100 hairs per day! With extensions in place, the natural shedding will sometimes be caught in the extension itself, giving the feeling of 'I've lost lots of hair!'. As long as you are gentle with removing the extensions, it will not cause damage to your natural hair
Cleanse —
Cleanse your hair twice with the Clarifying Shampoo to remove all traces of residue then condition as normal. Blow dry and style as desired!
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Before storing your Extensions, you will need to wash and prepare them, to eliminate any transfer of reidue and keep them pristine, ready for reapplication

Wash each row at a time - you can keep them in their elastic band or clip.

Using the Clarifying Shampoo, wash extensions twice taking care to keep them stacked and all in the same direction. Avoid rubbing them together or scrubbing them too vigorously as this will cause them to tangle.

Rinse the lathered shampoo out in warm (not hot) water.

Apply the Intense Hydrating Mask from mid lengths and ends, then comb through with a wide tooth comb.

Rinse conditioner in warm water.

for reapplication

Lay flat on a towel and wrap lengthways. Apply pressure to 'squeeze' water from extensions.

Keeping the extensions stacked, blast dry the hair in a downward direction on

a medium heat until the tape and the hair are 100% dry.

Store your extensions (keeping them in the rows that you took them out in)
