## A GUIDE TO FINDING YOUR RING SIZE

Choosing the right ring size can be a little difficult; whether it's for yourself, a partner or a friend. To make things easy, here are some of our tips and some printable tools to help you find your perfect ring size. We recommend visiting a local jeweller for the most accurate measurement. Please note we offer exchanges on rings.

### OUR TIPS

- Temperature and time of day are important. Try not to measure your hands when they are too hot or too cold. It's best to measure in the evening when they are at their largest.
- If you find yourself between two sizes, always go with the larger one.
- If you (like a lot of us) have slightly larger knuckles than the base of your finger, you'll want to go up a half size.
- If you are purchasing a ring which has a wider band, we advise going one size up.

### USE THE STRING METHOD TO FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Wrap a strip of paper or piece of string around your finger where you'd like your ring to sit.
2. Make sure that the paper/string is pulled tightly (not too tight, but hugging the finger snugly), just as a ring would fit.
3. Mark the spot where the paper/string meets and measure the distance with a ruler (mm).
4. Use our ring sizing chart to then determine your desired ring size.


## USE AN EXISTING RING TO FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

### Before printing

- Ensure that there are no scaling options selected when printing. If available, please select the 'Actual Size' option.
- Print on standard A4 paper (210x297mm).

### Once printed

1. Select an existing ring that fits your preferred finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below until the inside circumference of the ring matches a specific circle.
3. If your ring falls in between two sizes, consider the width of the band. A wider band may require a slightly larger ring size.




## USE A RING SIZER TO MEASURE YOUR FINGER

### Before printing

- Ensure that there are no scaling options selected.
- Print on standard A4 paper (210x297mm).
- The ring sizer should be 160mm in length.

### Once printed

1. Carefully cut out the ring sizer below.
2. Place the end of the ring sizer through the indicated slit to form a loop.
3. Wrap the loop around your finger with the letters either side visible. The letter that appears closest to the slit is your ring size.
