WHAT

When you pray with the Holy Spirit.

When you petition God for what you need and put your request in writing.

When you pray to ask for a clear path because you have multiple good directions to go.

When you pray to bind spirits or have spirits work for you based on the authority God has granted you.

WHERE

Acts 2:38 TLB

And Peter replied, "Each one of you must turn from sin, return to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; then you also shall receive this gift, the Holy Spirit.

Philippians 4:6 MSG

Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns.

Proverbs 3:6 TLB

In everything you do, put God first, and he will direct you and crown your efforts with success.

Matthew 18:18 TLB

And I tell you this—whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven, and whatever you free on earth will be freed in heaven.

HOW

If you have accepted Jesus Christ into your life you already have the gift of the Holy Spirit. Pray to God in the name of Jesus to give you the company of the Holy Spirit as it was promised to you. Also, try praying with someone who speaks in tongues and repeat their words or try to sing the words.

Supplication is a request, so tell God your needs. Take this prayer one step further and create an official contract with God. Write down specific requests and back up each request with scriptures. Once you have completed your contract date it, sign, and have it co-signed to make it official.

This is personal prayer and is not intended for others, so ask God to fulfill his plan for you. Jesus used this type of prayer when he asked God if his will for him was really to die on the cross. God revealed his will to Jesus and he died on the cross for our sins.

If you believe in Jesus you have the ability and authority from Jesus to bind and loose evil strongholds (depression, drug addition, suicide, etc). First, bind (tie it up) or loosen (untie) the stronghold you or someone else is facing in the name of Jesus Christ. Next, pray his will be done on earth as it is done in heaven - Matthew 6:10.

When you pray and believe that you will receive what you ask for.

When you are praying on behalf of others.

When you pray with praise, worship and thanksgiving.

When you pray in agreement with someone.

Matthew 21:22 MEV

Whatever you ask in prayer, if you believe, you will receive.

1 Timothy 2:1 TLB

Here are my directions: Pray much for others; plead for God's mercy upon them; give thanks for all he is going to do for them.

Colossians 3:16 TLB

Remember what Christ taught, and let his words enrich your lives and make you wise; teach them to each other and sing them out in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing to the Lord with thankful hearts.

Matthew 18:19 KJV

If two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Have faith and believe that all things are possible with Christ. Pray for God's will to be done, tell Him what you need, and pray in His name. Trust that God has a plan for you and that He knows what is best for you.

Intercession is a prayer that pleads with God for the needs of others. You use this prayer when you pray for your children's safety or pray for a friend to overcome addiction, you are praying and are interceding on their behalf. Spending more alone time and prayer with God will create a better relationship between and you and God and it will give you more confidence to intercede for others. Ask Him to help show you how to pray for others.
