## Hands-On History Activity-Pak: Artists Scope and Sequence

The Artists Activity Pak offers a hands-on view of the world of art. Students investigate different artists throughout history, many of the styles and mediums they used, and a variety of specific works of art. Students are also given opportunities to experiment with a wide range of art styles by "imitating the masters" with various forms of media. The Activity-Pak is designed to teach students through kinesthetic means, utilizing the senses and motor skills. Where younger students may need more guidance and assistance with the projects, older students should be able to handle the majority of the Activity-Pak independently.
