Hands-On History Activity-Pak: The New Testament Scope and Sequence

The New Testament Activity-Pak offers a hands-on view of the New Testament. Students investigate many classic stories and teachings from the New Testament such as the birth, miracles, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Beatitudes, the Fruit of the Spirit, and the Armor of God. They also learn about the missionary journeys of Paul and many of the Old Testament prophesies fulfilled by Jesus Christ. The Activity-Pak is designed to teach students through kinesthetic means, utilizing the senses and motor skills. Where younger students may need more guidance and assistance with the projects, older students should be able to handle the majority of the Activity-Pak independently.
