

History Through the Ages: Record of Time and Suggested Placement Guide on CD Scope and Sequence

The Record of Time and Suggested Placement Guide on CD is a supplemental product designed to go along with the *History Through the Ages Collection of Timeline Figures on CD* or the pre-printed timeline sets*. The *Record of Time on CD* provides a printable version of the breakdown of dated pages to hold the timeline figures and a guide for where to place each figure. The purpose of creating a timeline is to visually reinforce where in history a person lived or an event took place. As a student studies each important person or event (from ancient, world, Biblical, American history, etc.) they add the corresponding figure to the timeline, creating a continuous flowing picture of events. Students also see who was alive at the same time at any given moment throughout the world, making connections that may be difficult to do as the history of different geographic areas and people are studied from one year to the next. The *Record of Time on CD* is priced and designed for families needing three or more notebooks and who wish to print off their own copies at a more affordable price.

* Note: The pre-printed sets come in the wall size and should be copied smaller (reproducible within a family) before placing into the *Record of Time* notebook. Instructions for how small to reproduce the figures are included in each set.
