


## Auto fill Kit



### INSTALLATION GUIDE

#### STEP 1


Assemble connector



1. Unscrew the connector from the Auto fill box
2. Check which size of connector you will choose the one that fits better with your hose
3. Screw the **nut connector (1)** to the connector
4. Add the **small seal (2)**

#### STEP 2


Install the Auto fill Kit on the LifeStraw Community



1. Place the Auto fill box inlet through the hole on the LifeStraw Community.
2. Place **large seal (4)** on the inlet and then screw on the **nut (3)**
3. Screw the assembled connector to the inlet tightly to prevent leakage.

#### STEP 3

1. Connect the water hose to the Auto fill box
2. Connect the water hose to your tap in one end and to the connector tube on the LifeStraw Community on the other end.




**TIP:** You can use screw-clamps to secure the hose to the connector and to the tap. This is to prevent the hose from disconnecting due to high water pressure.

## DAILY MAINTENANCE

### STEP 1


Remove the Pre-filter



Remove the Pre-Filter. To do this, remove the snap at the bottom of the pre-filter using both hands. Then remove the 2 snaps at the top using both hands.

### STEP 2

Rinse under water



Gently clean the pre-filter with water by hand or with a tooth brush. Do not use soap when cleaning the Pre-filter. Place the pre-filter back on the auto fill.

### TIPS

For best performance, follow the daily maintenance for the auto fill kit and of the LifeStraw Community (as described in the LifeStraw Community User's Manual)

If the LifeStraw Community is not in use for longer than 2 days, turn off the tap and drain water from the unit to avoid standing water.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The LifeStraw Community Auto fill Kit is designed to work with the standard range of water pressure that comes from taps. The maximum working water pressure that can be used is 3 bar

The **LifeStraw® Community Auto fill** is designed to detect the water level on the dirty water tank and refill it automatically. This way, the user does not have to be preoccupied with monitoring water levels and manual refilling. Users will enjoy LifeStraw® Community **filters that are always full**, preventing drinking water shortages in the event of water cuts or disruptions. The LifeStraw® Community Autofill will ensure communities have constant access to safe drinking water.
